

# **5409/5404** PE Double Sided Utility Foam Tape

### DESCRIPTION

Scapa 5409 is a double-sided foam bonding tape designed for general low load applications. The 5409 is black. The 5404 is white. The Polyethylene foam is predominantly closed celled. An aggressive high tack acrylic pressure sensitive adhesive is coated on both sides and the product has either an amber paper or blue plastic release liner.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

Ideal bonding substrates are those which are: clean, dry, flat, smooth, dust free & non-porous

Low temperatures may increase the risk of condensation, reducing the tack of the product. Life expectancy will vary with temperature and humidity. Product may be applied by hand direct from a roll applying even pressure.
